



This week we heard a parable about the kingdom of heaven. Jesus taught that the kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who goes out to hire people to work for him. He goes out in the morning, and again a few hours later, and again a few hours after that. At the end of the day, each person is paid the same amount, regardless of the time the worked. When those who had worked the longest complained that the landowner's compensation scheme was unfair, the landowner pointed out that each person had been paid exactly as they had agreed, and besides, it was the landowner's right to be generous to those who had worked for him.

Talk about it: Do we ever get hung up on what other people are getting? It can be especially difficult when we see other people getting the things we want or think we deserve. What does this parable teach us about “keeping our eyes on our own paper” ?
